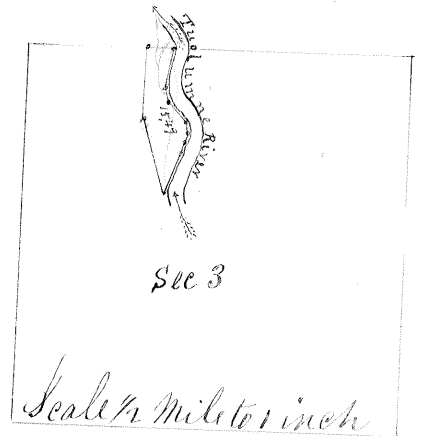

place of beginning
