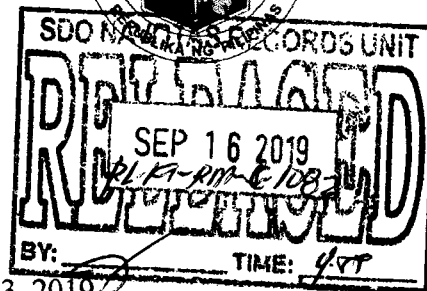

The activity aims to help educational institutions improve their teachers' competencies and teaching strategies in Mathematics and Science. The target participants are the school heads, coordinators and teaches.

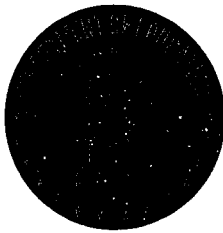
